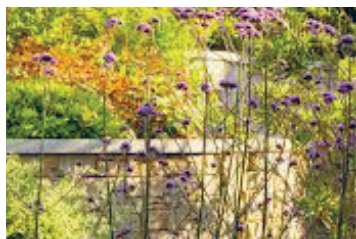

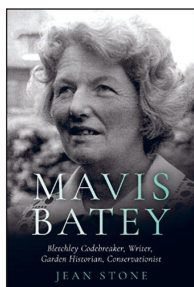
Summer Events – 2020

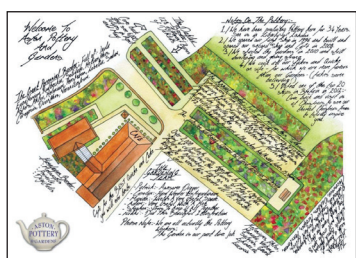
2.30pm at the County Museum, Aylesbury HP20 2QP
